

ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE




2021 ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

The search for our first Worship Pastor demanded most of the attention of the Board in 2021. Multiple meetings, candidate interviews and Zooms proved fruitful for the Unity Vision!

The following actions taken in 2021:

- 1. In April 2021, the Board of Directors unanimously approved to extend an offer to Jacob Roberts as our first full time Worship Pastor.
- 2. In September 2021, the Board of Directors unanimously approved a cost of living increase for Pastor, Youth Pastor, Worship Pastor and Administrative Assistant of 2.5%.
- 3. Board of Directors approved a \$7,000 increase for Youth Pastor with intent to meet a shortcoming of benefits and cost of living increase.

Discipleship Groups

In January 2021, we began the process of restarting our Sunday morning in-person Discipleship Groups (formerly known as Sunday school). I would like to thank all the group leaders for their hard work, time, and support of this ministry. We started with one Sunday morning class that was opened to all ages, which met in the youth modular in between the 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. services. As we transitioned back to a single service on Sunday morning, the class relocated to a classroom inside the main building, meeting at 9 a.m. In late July, we added one class for children pre-K thru 6th grade in the main building and the students (7th -12th grade) began meeting out in the youth modular. Also new this year, we switched to digital curriculum for all classes using the Gospel Project. The digital curriculum is cheaper than printed materials and we have access to additional resources that we were unable to purchase in the past. The digital curriculum also allows the group leader to email a digital copy of the Gospel Project discipleship guide to participants in the group at no cost. If you prefer a physical copy, participants can purchase their own copy of the discipleship guide through Lifeway.com.

The plan moving forward will be to conduct quarterly training for our group leaders, while actively seeking and recruiting new leaders. The hope and prayer for the upcoming year is to grow our discipleship groups by reaching, teaching, and ministering to not only our members but to the unchurched individuals within our community. May we be a people devoted to the Word, to prayer, and to care for each other and for the unbeliever, open to the Spirit's work. I am looking forward to what God has in store for upcoming year!

Annual Business Meeting Report - Children's Ministry

2021 was an awesome year of ministry and really challenged and focused our methods of discipleship. Our main focus was giving families the tools they needed for discipleship at home. We were able to integrate Zoom meetings with online check-in on Sunday nights for families that were not comfortable coming back to in person classes. We also utilized Word of Life's video's and discussion questions by posting them on our children's Facebook group for parents to watch with their kids and then lead discussion afterwards.

In December the children's ministry team was excited to bless families with a Christmas present from the ministry to encourage intentional family time and discipleship. The team hand delivered bags to every family in the church with children in grades K-6th which contained a board game centered around Jesus' birth, a nativity ornament, star cookie cutters and a sugar cookie recipe and a book for parents encouraging family discipleship.

Our Word of Life participation was consistent throughout the year and we had six children and 2 leaders complete Gold requirements for the year. Group events were still limited due to Covid but we did have a Christmas party and ended the year with a pool party at Battlefield pool. It was great to be able to hang out with everyone in person and have some fun together.

We had to cancel camp again this year due to Covid but hope to be able to start attending again in 2022.

Vacation Bible School was planned for 2021 but was cancelled out of caution to help contain a Covid exposure in the church to the small group that was affected. That decision was successful as no one outside of that group was affected. We are looking forward to VBS in 2022 and are ready to dig in to Concrete and Cranes!

Leaders had the summer off and we had a very strong Word of Life kick-off in September. We are excited to have Brooke Damron join the kids ministry team as a Gopher leader and love to see the hearts of youth lead them to service as soon as they graduate.

Bronze is due November 21st and we have more than ½ the kids and most of the leaders on track to complete it by the deadline.

With the cancellation of the Fall Festival, the kids ministry hosted a Nerf and Nacho's night on October 31st. It was an awesome time with 20 children total in attendance; 4 from the community that do not attend Unity. The kids started the night off with target practice and warm up, then moved into dinner and headed out for multiple Nerf games. We ended the night with a devotion on our Word of Life verse, Philippians 3:14 and talked about how our mark in life should be Jesus Christ. We hope to be able to host another event in the future, possibly as a back to school event.
