ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE





UNITY AT GLANCE 2023-2024

A Year of Growth, Community, and Service

As we reflect on the year 2023-2024, we are filled with gratitude and joy for the remarkable journey our congregation has undertaken. Unity Baptist Church has witnessed significant growth, both in spirit and in numbers, and has continued to serve our community with love and dedication. Here are the highlights of our year:

New Spaces for Fellowship and Worship

Opening of Mac 2 and Mac 3 On January 21, 2024, we officially opened Mac 2 and Mac 3, two large modulars that have been meticulously remodeled over the past year and a half. These new spaces are a testament to our commitment to expanding our Discipleship Groups and offering additional spaces for Gospel-centered activities. Our growing church community needed this expansion, and we are excited to welcome more members into these beautiful new areas.

Youth Mac Remodeling Project We are also thrilled to announce that the Youth modular is in the midst of a significant remodeling project. This upgrade will provide our Youth with a well-deserved improvement of their space, including a bigger stage, better sound system, kitchenette, and bathrooms. We look forward to seeing our Youth thrive in this enhanced environment.

Acts of Service and Community Engagement

Disaster Relief for Hurricane Helene In September, we responded to the call for disaster relief in North Carolina and Damascus following Hurricane Helene. Our church members, along with the community, rallied together to provide much-needed support. We extend our heartfelt thanks to Jadee Raglan at Unity and Grayson Chretien in Clyde, North Carolina for their leadership and dedication during this effort.

Monthly Blood Drives Our commitment to community service continues with our monthly Blood Drives in partnership with the American Red Cross. These events have been a vital part of our outreach, and we are grateful for the ongoing participation and support from our church family.

Spiritual Growth and New Members

Baptisms and New Members We celebrate the spiritual growth within our congregation, with 18 individuals accepting the Lord and being baptized this year. Additionally, we have welcomed 28 new members into our church family, reflecting the vibrant and growing community at Unity.

Celebrating One Year with Good News Club (GNC) This year marked our one-year anniversary with the Good News Club at Middle Road Elementary School. We are proud of the positive impact this program has had on young hearts and minds, spreading the message of God's love and hope. We are thrilled to maintain our presence in all elementary schools across Prince George, aiming to touch the lives of even more children through this transformative program.

To sustain and expand this wonderful initiative, we are seeking additional volunteers. The children have been incredibly receptive to the message, and with your support, we can continue to make a meaningful difference in their lives.

Educational and Worship Initiatives

Adult English as a Second Language Classes From May to July, we successfully launched our first year of Adult English as a Second Language (ESL) class. These classes have provided valuable learning opportunities and fostered a sense of community among participants.

New Sunday Worship Schedule In March 2024, we introduced a new Sunday Worship Schedule with the first service at 8:30 AM and the second service at 10:45 AM. This change has allowed us to accommodate our growing congregation and provide more opportunities for worship and fellowship.

New Discipleship Classes With the opening of Mac 3, we started new Discipleship Classes at 9:45 AM on January 21st, 2024. The attendance and enthusiasm for these classes have been remarkable, reflecting the hunger for spiritual growth and connection within our church community.

Outreach and Community Events

Ladies Outreach Opportunities Our ladies have been active in several outreach opportunities throughout the year, including Cookies for Christmas and Gospel-centered activities for The Backpack Program. These initiatives have touched many lives and demonstrated the love and generosity of our congregation.

Sponsor a Child for the Backpack Program We launched a new initiative to sponsor a child for The Backpack Program. A one-time donation of \$100 will feed a child in need every weekend for

one school year. This program has received an overwhelming response, and we are grateful for the support from our church family.

First Gingerbread Bash In December 2023, we hosted our first Gingerbread Bash, where families built gingerbread nativity scenes and learned about the Christmas Story. This event brought joy and festive spirit to all who attended.

Christmas Caroling and Auction Our annual Christmas caroling brought cheer to many, while the Christmas Auction organized by one of our Discipleship Groups for our Mission BIG Give was a resounding success. In December 2023, we raised \$1,600 for missions, the highest amount yet!

Prince George Christmas Parade Our Youth and Children's ministries had a blast participating in the Prince George Christmas Parade, where the Youth won the Most Spirited float! The float, showcasing a white church surrounded by Christmas trees, was a true testament to their creativity and spirit. We extend our heartfelt thanks to Pastor Chris for his inspiring vision.

Operation Christmas Child We collected 162 Christmas Shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child, a Samaritan's Purse initiative that sends gift-filled shoeboxes to children in need around the world, along with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Partnering with Good News Club teams, we hosted our first ever Gingerbread Bash. This was an awesome gospel centered event. We had about 20 families in attendance and are looking forward to hosting it again this year.

We ended our WOL year in June with our annual pool party and awards celebration. We had 35 children, and 6 leaders complete the requirements for Gold this year and 2 earn the Steadfast award! We also attended Centrikid camp in June. We had 11 children, 3 leaders and 1 Teen Assistant attend. The theme for the week was God Gives Amazing Gifts; children and leaders came home challenged and encouraged in their faith.
